### **Drop off and Collection Reminders**

Just a reminder that although many restrictions are being lifted from Monday, we will be continuing to keep all of our risk assessments in place until the end of term, to protect our pupils, families and staff.

Please continue to wear masks when on site, drop off and collection time are busy times.

Please continue to only enter through the gate on Montpelier Road and exit through the gate to the park, following the one way system.

## Remote Learning

Over the past few weeks, we have had several people requesting remote learning for their children.

If your child is self-isolating or shielding due to the ongoing covid pandemic, your class teacher will provide online learning for them.

However, if children are absent from school for other reasons, we are not able to provide remote learning.

All pupils who are well enough to be learning should be in school, unless they are shielding or self-isolating.
