

COVID information

With so many children recently returning to school, we have had several children showing some of the symptoms linked to coronavirus. Whilst we do understand how challenging it is at this time, as a school we must continue to follow our Risk Assessments and the advice given by Croydon Local Authority and the Department for Education. The current list of symptoms include:

- · a new continuous cough
- · a high temperature
- · a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

Following our Risk Assessment and the current Government Guidelines from the Department for Education, you should:

• Request a coronavirus test immediately. The test only works for the five days after symptoms started. Order a test: <u>https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing-and-tracing/ask-for-a-test-to-check-if-you-have-coronavirus/</u> This must be a PCR test; we CAN NOT accept the results of an LFT test, these are designed to identify asymptomatic cases within the wider community and are not as accurate.

• Your child should then self-isolate until the result of the test is known. Your child CAN NOT return to school until the results are received from the PCR Test.

• Please keep the school informed about symptoms, self-isolation and test results

If the test result comes back positive, then they should isolate for 10 days. If the test is negative, then they can return when they are well enough.

Electric scooters - message from Croydon

"As the new term begins could I ask you to inform parents and Carers not to use Electric scooters to transport children to and from school. Before the summer break it was brought to our attention that more and more adults are using this mode of transport with children on board.

Although Electric scooters are seen across the borough "Privately-owned e-scooters, which are widely available to buy online, are illegal to use on public roads, cycle lanes and pavements. The only **place a private e-scooter can be used is on private land**, with the permission of the landowner."

There has been an increase of E scooter collisions and unfortunately fatalities over the past few months. I am currently working with TfL on how we can deal with this issue in Croydon".
